## Introduction

In the nine articles approved to be published in this volume the issue presented and discussed can be defined as *Discourse Perspectives of Science Divulgation/ Popularization*. This research area is made explicit in the editorial signed by its three *ad hoc* editors, namely *Sheila Vieira de Camargo Grillo* (USP), *Maria Eduarda Giering* (UNISINUS) e *Désirée Motta-Roth* (UFSM), who are experts in this field.
