



PRESENTATION

The current issue of *Cognitio – Revista de Filosofia* consolidates the new style we have adopted for this periodical, namely the continuous flow process, which concludes in 2023 with a volume encompassing the articles that were approved from the submissions received.

Another important aspect is that *Cognitio* absorbed the previously separate periodical *Cognitio - Estudos*, while maintaining the characteristics of its sister journal, both published by the PUC-SP Center for Studies in Pragmatism. *Cognitio – Estudos*, founded in 2004, was created with the aim of providing a space for the dissemination of work by young researchers and, with a lesser emphasis, some short articles written by senior researchers. *Cognitio – Revista de Filosofia*, on the other hand, has always been dedicated to publishing texts by national and international scholars who are already renowned in the journal's field of research. It must be said that before this fusion, both periodicals enjoyed the same Qualis-Capes rating of excellence.

The reason for this fusion, it is worth remembering, was to simplify the entire editorial operation carried out by two interacting teams from the Center for Studies in Pragmatism which, in the end, merged into a single one, facilitating the logistics involved in the work of publication, obviously maintaining the rigorous selection criteria and the general quality of the texts approved for both areas of publication.

Despite *Cognitio*'s focus on classical and contemporary Pragmatism and correlated disciplines such as Semiotics, its editorial approach has always encouraged the submission of texts that directly or obliquely establish theoretical relationships with this main focus. However, one must consider the difficulties of keeping the number of articles required by the corresponding Qualis-Capes classification within the necessary standard of excellence, given that the publication's focus, even considering its flexibility in theoretical interfacing, characterizes it as specific to a particular area of research in philosophy. This differentiates it from other journals in Brazilian philosophy, also classified as excellent, which cover a much wider range of topics, facilitating the reception of a considerable thematic diversity of articles.

Despite the editorial difficulties brought about by *Cognitio*'s thematic specialization, we have kept the journal within the standards of excellence required by Capes. This year, *Cognitio* marks its twenty-fourth anniversary, having already welcomed in its editions papers by the majority of renowned national and international scholars in the field. This history of the journal makes it, on the one hand, a solidifying force in the focus of research related to pragmatism in Brazil, and, on the other, considered by foreign scholars as one of the few leading specialized journals in the area published in the world.

Readers of this issue will find a range of carefully selected works that will certainly appeal to those who are not only interested in the specific themes of pragmatism, but also those who generally appreciate carefully sophisticated Philosophy.
