PRESENTATION

The 25th issue of *Cognitio: Revista de Filosofia*, published throughout the year 2024, represents an important contribution to philosophical research, serving both Brazilian and international audiences.

Starting this year, the unpublished contributions are divided into three paper sections. The first section, titled *Cognitio Papers*, features contributions from national and international researchers with deep expertise in studies on Pragmatism and its related themes. The second section, titled *Cognitio-Estudos Papers*, presents works by recent PhDs and young researchers addressing themes of classical and contemporary Pragmatism in its various branches. The third section, titled *Varia*, reflects our efforts to bring Cognitio's discussions closer to topics not necessarily tied to the theoretical universe of Pragmatism. Here, readers will find diverse themes, no less relevant to contemporary philosophical debates.

This edition also includes the dossier *Hegel and Logic*, the result of works from the 8th Meeting "Readings of Hegel's Logic", involving various study groups on Hegel's philosophy in Brazil. The dossier was organized by Adilson Feiler (FAJE), Agemir Bavaresco (PUCRS), and Ricardo Pereira Tassinari (UNESP), guest editors who have brought forth this remarkable collection of studies in Hegelian philosophy.

In addition to six papers in the *Cognitio* section, nine in the *Cognitio-Estudos* section, four in the *Varia* section, and eight papers in the *Hegel and Logic* dossier, this issue also includes four translations, two book reviews, and one testimonial – a total of 34 texts of exceptional intellectual merit, resulting from rigorous research.

A significant change, implemented in September 2024, was the establishment of a minimum requirement for submissions: at least one of the authors must hold a PhD. This new standard will apply to future editions, aligning the journal with the leading philosophy periodicals in the country.

Cognitio, now celebrating its 25th anniversary, continues its vital role in disseminating research to a community of scholars attuned to its theoretical focus. Over the years, the journal has published works by some of the most respected scholars worldwide, solidifying its position as one of the most important periodicals in its field, both nationally and internationally.
